## Little Black Dress Pinot Grigio

Little Black Dress wines are the perfect accessories to formal sit-down dinners or casual appetizer parties since they're so approachable and pack a big bang for the buck. This recently released Pinot Grigio is a light-bodied wine with some citrus notes and a hint of spice. It's been fermented in 100 per cent stainless steel in an effort to highlight the fruit flavours. Enjoy on its own or with pan-seared pickerel with lemon.

## Sibling Rivalry White

Three brothers, three grape varieties and one cool new wine concept. Sibling Rivalry White is a blend of Riesling, Chardonnay and Gewürztraminer from the Speck family's Henry of Pelham Estate Vineyards in Niagara. The result is fresh-tasting wine with citrus, apple and lychee flavours. A treat on its own or try it with a fruit and cheese plate.

## Claro Shiraz

If you are looking for a wine that truly delivers huge value, look no further than Claro Shiraz. From Shiraz grapes grown in some of the best locations in Chile's Central Valley, this medium-bodied wine packs a wallop of jammy blueberry and black plum flavours. Enjoy it with a bison burger for a match made in heaven.

## Espiritu De Argentina Malbec

Argentina is famous for Malbec, and the grapes from this wine come from its premier winegrowing region of Mendoza. Ideal growing conditions produced a full-bodied wine with black cherry and cassis flavours. Aged a year in oak, the wine shows notes of toasty vanilla and would be an excellent partner to a medium-rare grilled steak.

## HobNob Merlot

The verb *to hobnob* originally meant "to drink together," and this Merlot from France produced in a New World winemaking style is approachable, contemporary and delicious. Savour the flavours of ripe plum and blackberry with a velvety texture and soft finish. Try with roast veal or tomato-based pastas.
